Dear parents,

Re: Arrangements regarding the extension of the Chinese New Year holidays

The Education Bureau announced that all schools, including kindergartens, primary schools, secondary schools and special schools will extend their Chinese New Year holidays to March 1 (i.e. class resumption on March 2). During the extension of Chinese New Year holidays, the school will implement the following arrangements:

1. To make good preparation for class resumption, school will thoroughly clean the premises to ensure a clean and hygiene environment, as well as strengthen health education. In addition, the school will prepare for cleaning and disinfection items to cater for the needs of individual students.
2. During the period of class suspension, the school premises will open on school days and we will arrange staff to be on duty. If your children need to return to school, parents please check the temperature of the student. Moreover, students need to fill in a health declaration form (see attached) and bring their own masks (at least four), and parents must also wear masks when entering the school. If the student is unwell, he/she should seek medical advice as soon as possible.
3. All school, dormitory and parent activities, competitions and parent assisting student's therapy at school to be held in February will be cancelled or postponed.
4. Although the original period of the Chinese New Year holidays is extended, students should stick to their travel plan and return to Hong Kong as scheduled and those gone to the Mainland for holiday should come back as early as possible to reduce the risk of infection. Within 14 days after returning to Hong Kong, students should take a daily temperature measurement and seek medical advice as soon as possible if they are unwell.
5. During extended holidays, students should stay at home and avoid traveling or going to crowded places to prevent infection.
6. As the Chinese New Year holidays is extended to March 1, **the school bus fee and lunch fee for February will be exempted**. If parents have already paid the fees, they will be refunded.
7. Parents who have not submitted the applications for \$2,500 Student Grant (2019/20) are kindly requested to return the completed forms on the first day of class resumption. If parents have any difficulties, please contact class teacher or social worker.
8. The school will notify parents/students via intranet email about the home study arrangements from February 5 onwards.
