Dear Parents,

Re: Arrangements of Continue to Suspend Face-to-face Classes for All Schools

The Government announced on 4 January that the COVID-19 pandemic remains severe and volatile, all schools would suspend face-to-face classes and school activities until the school Lunar New Year holidays. Our School will still switch to online teaching to let students study at home and adopt the following measures:

1. Studying Arrangements:
 - Ordinary Curriculum (online lessons for the following subjects will be arranged according to the current half-day timetable)
 - Primary classes: Chinese, English, Mathematics, General Studies, Putonghua
 - Junior Secondary classes: Chinese, English, Mathematics, Life and Society
 - Senior Secondary classes: Chinese, English, Mathematics, Liberal Studies, Information and Communication Technology, Economics, Biology
 - Adaptive Curriculum (online lessons timetable has been notified by the class teacher)
 - Primary and Junior Secondary classes: Chinese, Mathematics, General Studies, Life Education
 - Senior Secondary classes: Chinese, Mathematics, Liberal Studies, Information and Communication Technology
 - The learning content is updated in Google drive every week for students to study at home.
2. Examination arrangement: First Semester Examination will be cancelled (except for the mock exams in the S.6 class of ordinary curriculum).
3. Parents' Day arrangement: The parent-teacher conference of the first term semester will be held via online/phone.
4. Therapy arrangement: Therapists will contact parents and provide online therapy lessons or therapy materials to students as needed.
5. Fee arrangement: Non-boarders are exempted from paying school bus fee for January 2021.
6. The school will thoroughly clean the campus to ensure that the environment is clean and hygienic, and prepare cleaning and disinfection items to prepare for future face-to-face classes.
7. During the suspension of face-to-face classes, the school premises will remain open and there will be staff on duty. If parents need to send students back to school, please call and contact the class teacher in advance, check the student's body temperature beforehand and fill out a health declaration form. Please also bring at least two backup surgical masks and enough paper towels. Parents also need to wear masks when picking up and dropping off students. If you feel unwell, please seek medical advice as soon as possible.
8. All the school activities originally scheduled during this period including the school, dormitory and parent-to-face activities, competitions, and parent-to-school as helpers in therapy training sessions will be cancelled or postponed.
9. During this period, students should avoid going to crowded places with poor ventilation. Students should maintain a balanced diet, exercise regularly, and take adequate rest in order to strengthen their immunity.
